MEETINGS WITH YOUR INSTRUCTOR & ON-SITE SUPERVISOR

Before your internship or other experience, meet with your faculty advisor for advice in choosing an internship well-suited to your long-term plans and/or academic interests; explore and propose possible research topics that connect the content of your internship with the content of your concentration.

<u>During your internship, arrange at least one meeting with your site supervisor (one-third/one-half of the way through)</u> for feedback on your performance. It takes work to supervise an intern – by making the job easier for them, you are making yourself a better intern!

<u>During the semester, consult with your instructor of record at least three times</u>: <u>Once</u>, to confirm your paper topic (in September) and expectations re: "the perfect research paper."; <u>once</u> to confirm the direction your paper is taking (mid-October/early November); <u>and again</u> to confirm the Due Date (December 1 in Fall and May 1 in Spring). Due date may be subject to change due to instructor preference.
